01 WELCOME TO TSINGHUA



About Tsinghua

Tsinghua University was established in 1911, originally under the name "Tsinghua Xuetang." The school was renamed "Tsinghua School" in 1912, while the name "National Tsinghua University" was later adopted in 1928.

In 1937, due to the War of Resistance Against Japanese Invasion, Tsinghua University was forced to move to Kunming, in Yunnan province, and joined together with Peking University and Nankai University to form the Southwest Associated University. In 1946, the University was moved back to its original location in Beijing.

After the founding of the People's Republic of China, during the nationwide restructuring of universities and colleges undertaken in 1952, the University was molded into a polytechnic

institute focusing on engineering. Mr. Jiang Nanxiang became President of the University. He made significant contributions in leading Tsinghua to become the national center for training outstanding engineers and scientists.

Since China opened up to the world in 1978, Tsinghua University has developed into a comprehensive research university at a breathtaking pace. At present, Tsinghua University has 33 schools, 54 departments, and 16 colleges. It has developed into a comprehensive, research-oriented, and open university covering 12 academic disciplines, including science, engineering, literature, fine arts, history, philosophy, economics, management, law, education, medicine, and interdisciplinary studies.

Getting to Tsinghua

Beijing International Airports

Beijing has two international airports: Beijing Capital International Airport (in Beijing's Chaoyang District) and Beijing Daxing International Airport (in Beijing's Daxing District). Some airlines only fly into one of the two airports. Please check in advance which airport is most suitable for your arrival and travel needs.

Arriving at Beijing Capital International Airport

Taxi

For those coming to Beijing for the first time, taking a taxi from the airport to Tsinghua University is the most convenient. Follow the airport's signs to find the taxi stand and wait in line for a taxi. Legally operated taxis have standardized markings and signs. To ensure personal safety, do not take illegally operated taxis ("hackers"). The taxi fare from Capital International Airport to Tsinghua University should be about 150 RMB. International scholars can provide their apartment address to the driver, while international students can ask the driver to arrive at the Zijing Apartment Area through the northeast gate of Tsinghua University. (You can express it in Chinese as “我要到清华大学东北门的紫荆公寓”.)

Subway/Rail

The Beijing Capital Airport offers an express train service, which is an affordable and reliable option for getting into the city. The express train has 5 stops: Terminal 2 and Terminal 3 at the airport, followed by Dongzhimen (东直门), Sanyuanqiao (三元桥)

and Beixinqiao (北新桥) in downtown Beijing. The operating hours of each stop can be found in the following table:

The following figure recommends the quickest way to Tsinghua. Get off at Sanyuanqiao station, take subway line 10 to Zhichunlu (知春路) station, and transfer to Line 13. Take Line 13 to Wudaokou (五道口) station. Once at Wudaokou, go out through Exit A and take Bus 549 to Dashiqiao (大石桥), which will bring you to the northeast gate of Tsinghua University. The total cost of the journey is 32 RMB for one person.



Airport Bus

You can take the Zhongguancun (中关村) route, which stops at the Tsinghua Science Park (清华科技园). A one-way bus ticket costs roughly 30 RMB and service starts at 6:50 am and concludes at midnight. After getting off at Tsinghua Science Park, take a taxi to the Tsinghua University northeast gate (approximately 15 RMB), or take Bus 549 from the nearest stop, Wudaokou (五道口), to Dashiqiao (大石桥) (only 2 RMB). Arriving at Beijing Daxing International Airport

Taxi

For those coming to Beijing for the first time, taking a taxi from the airport to Tsinghua University is the most convenient. Follow the airport signs to locate the taxi stand. Legally operated taxis have standardized markings and signs. To ensure personal safety, do not take illegally operated taxis ("hackers"). The fare from Daxing International Airport to Tsinghua University is about 300 RMB. International scholars can provide their apartment address to the driver. International students can ask the driver to arrive the Zijing Apartment Area through the northeast gate of Tsinghua University. (You can express it in Chinese as “我要到清华大学东北门的紫荆公寓”.)

Subway/Rail

The Daxing International Airport offers an express train service, which has stops at Daxing Airport, Daxing Xincheng, and Caoqiao on the Daxing Airport Line. Its operating hours are from 6:00-23:00.

Airport Bus

The airport also has various bus routes heading downtown. For more information, refer to the official website of Daxing International Airport: <https://www.bdia.com.cn/#/>. Toggle the flag on the top right corner of the website to change languages.



The following figure recommends the quickest way to Tsinghua. Take the Metro Daxing Airport Line to Caoqiao station (草桥), transfer to subway Line 19 and take it to Mudanyuan (牡丹园) station. Change to take Line 10 to Zhichunlu (知春路) station, and transfer to subway Line 13 until Wudaokou (五道口) station. Once at Wudaokou, go out through Exit A and take Bus 549 two stops to Dashiqiao (大石桥), which will bring you to the northeast gate of Tsinghua University. The total cost of the journey is 42 RMB per person.



Local Sim Card

There are currently 3 Chinese mobile service providers that have branches located on the Tsinghua University campus. Temporary service stalls are located in C Building (C楼) on the day of enrollment registration.

Requirements for Purchasing a Chinese SIM Card:
When purchasing a Chinese SIM card, please bring your passport. You can choose to pay with RMB in cash, WeChat, or Alipay.

Notes:

- The national code for China is 86, and the Beijing telephone area code is 010.
- After purchasing a Chinese SIM card, please memorize your new Chinese mainland phone number.
- A Chinese mainland mobile phone number is required in order to apply for a Chinese bank card or a residence permit for foreigners.

Internet

Internet Services

Basic Services for students:

- Dynamic IPv4 address, free IPv4 traffic
- Dynamic IPv6 address, free IPv6 traffic
- A maximum of 5 devices connected at the same time
- 1 email address

Basic Services for faculty:

- Dynamic IPv4 address, 50 GB off-campus IPv4 traffic monthly
- Dynamic IPv6 address, free IPv6 traffic
- A maximum of 5 devices connected at the same time
- 1 email address

After the data consumption of off-campus IPv4 exceeds 50 GB, the price is 1 RMB/GB.

How to Top up Your Internet Account

Online:

Students and scholars can top up their internet account online by logging onto (<https://userg.tsinghua.edu.cn/>). On the left-hand menu, click on "Self-Payment" (自助缴费) and then complete the payment via mobile payment (WeChat or Alipay). Note that if fees are owed, log on by choosing to access the on-campus route (校内访问) and then use WeChat pay or Alipay to complete the payment.

On WeChat:

After connecting your campus card to the Tsinghua University Official Information Services WeChat Platform (清华大学信息服务微信企业), students and scholars can go to the "Information User Services" (信息化服务) page to recharge their internet account by using WeChat Pay.

In-Person:

Internet accounts can be topped up in Room B104 of the Lee Shau Kee Science and Technology Building (李兆基科技大楼 B104), Monday to Friday from 13:00 to 16:00. Currently only cash is accepted. (Holiday and winter/summer break working hours will be announced separately.)

Internet Account Set-Up

After registering at Tsinghua, international students or scholars will receive a personal internet account verification code. After receiving the verification code, scan the QR code below to download the instruction file for activation. International scholars can refer to the instruction file but select the "I am faculty/staff" option, and follow the prompts to activate your account. The website language can be changed to English via the button at the top right.

Accessing the Internet

Once an internet account has been successfully activated, you can access the internet via LAN ports located in your university accommodation and/or wireless networks accessible throughout the entire campus (Wi-Fi network named "Tsinghua" or any network name starting with "Tsinghua"). When choosing to connect the network, your system may pop up the authentication website, or you may log into <https://login.tsinghua.edu.cn> by yourself. Then authorize your device with your username and password on the website. Note that Tsinghua University websites can be accessed without consuming data if you uncheck the "access to the network outside the school" (访问校外网络) button before clicking "connect to the network" (连接网络). When going offline, click "disconnect" to completely disconnect from the network to prevent unnecessary data consumption.

To manage your internet account, including to manually disconnect a separate device from the Internet, check your current internet balance or view other account information, log into <http://usereg.tsinghua.edu.cn>. Students and scholars can directly download applications through <http://usereg.tsinghua.edu.cn> or <http://its.tsinghua.edu.cn> to use other information services.

Campus Computer Labs

All Tsinghua teaching staff and students can, without reservations, access campus computer labs, which are located near the northwest entrance of the Main Building (enter through the terrace).

These computer labs are open every day from 8:00 to 22:00. The service phone for the computer lab is 62782820.

On-Campus Canteens

Tsinghua has numerous canteens that serve dishes with various flavours prepared to strict food safety standards. Meals are provided for breakfast, lunch and dinner. These canteens can be classified into 3 main groups: canteens for students, canteens for faculty and special canteens. Most canteens provide counter service. The 1st floor of Yushu Yuan, the 3rd floor of Guanchou Yuan, the 3rd floor of Taoli Yuan and the 1st floor of Xichun Yuan all offer order-style table service. Students looking for Halal options can also go to Muslim-style restaurants (the southwest part of Guanchou Yuan), Qingqing Niula (the 2nd floor of Tingtao Yuan), the 1st floor of Zhilan Yuan (near Zijing Apartment Building 23), and the northwest flavour counter on the 1st floor of Shuangqing Yuan.

For registered students and scholars, meals in campus canteens can be paid for using the Campus ID card, or "Xiaoyuan Code" (校园码, a QR code), or NFC-capable phones linked to the Campus ID card. Note: students' Campus ID cards are effective in canteens for students and most canteens for faculty, while faculty members' cards are usually not effective in student canteens. In the previously mentioned canteens which offer order-style services, cash, WeChat, Alipay and other payment methods are allowed as well. For non-degree program students, the recharge and payment system is different; such details are subject to the program notice.

On-Campus Coffee Shops and Bubble Tea Shops

A variety of coffee shops and bubble tea shops are spread across the campus. Most of these are near canteens or inside libraries. Paying with RMB using cash, WeChat, or Alipay, is accepted.

Off-Campus Dining

In the nearby Wudaokou (五道口) area, restaurants with various cuisines are available, including Western, Korean, Japanese, and different Chinese cuisines. Fast food chains such as McDonald's, KFC, Pizza Hut, and Yoshinoya can be found easily.

When eating out, pay attention to food safety. Dazhong Dianping (大众点评) provides a vast array of reviews and information on dining, shopping, leisure and entertainment. Before dining out, you can check reviews for restaurants on the website Dazhong Dianping (<http://www.dianping.com>), or on its app.

Food Delivery

Take-away foods are permitted to be delivered into the campus and they can be ordered via third-party delivery apps (as follows) or by calling the restaurant directly. Food ordered on food delivery apps can be paid for using WeChat, Alipay, or via bank card. Most apps require advanced mobile payment before the food is delivered. The wait-time for deliveries is normally between 30 minutes and 1 hour. During peak hours, food should be ordered in advance to avoid delays. When the food delivery arrives, the delivery worker will call the mobile number that was provided when the order was made.

Food and Drinks

Drinking Water

Tap water is not suitable for drinking in China. Large bottles of water can be purchased at the supermarket, though many people tend to order water jugs which, once empty, can be replaced with full ones after contacting the delivery workers. These jugs sit on a water dispenser base that, when plugged in, can also heat or cool water. Before selecting a supplier, it is recommended to first become familiar with nearby



water supply companies to learn their basic prices. A single water tank should cost between 10 and 20 RMB and the initial deposit is between 50 and 100 RMB (familiarize yourself with the conditions for reclaiming your deposit beforehand). A water jug dispenser can be complimentary or purchased for an additional fee. Scholars can call the on-campus water supplier (via 62794646) for the detailed information (Please note - Chinese language only). For students living on campus, questions concerning ordering water jugs can also be directed towards the student dormitory management staff.



Shopping

On-Campus Supermarkets

There are 6 supermarkets on campus, which stock daily essentials. Payment at these places can be made through cash, WeChat or Alipay. Some information is listed in the table below.

Zijing Student Service Center (C Building)

Known as C Building for its resemblance to the letter C in shape, the Zijing Student Service Center is located beside the Zijing Sports Field, in the heart of the student dormitory area of campus. C Building hosts various shops and services, including a supermarket, hairdresser, post office, bank, ATM, bookshop, photography studio, glasses store, computer repair shop, souvenir shop, print shop, and student registration services.



Other On-Campus Service Shops

Pharmacies/Drugstores

Tong Ren Tang pharmacy (同仁堂药店) is located opposite to the Zhaolanyuan Caixian Guomei Supermarket (照澜院菜鲜果美超市). The pharmacy supplies both Traditional Chinese and Western medicine.

Photography studios

There are 3 photo studios on campus, offering photo printing and other photography related services.

- Huangshan Photo Shop (east of the Zhaolanyuan China Post)
- 1st floor of C building (near North gate)
- Under Dufeng Shuyuan (in Qingxi Cultural Corridor, east of Guanchou Yuan)

Optical/Eyeglass stores

Three total: Located Underground of C Building, in Zhaolanyuan, and in Qingxi Cultural Corridor (east of Guanchou Yuan).

Electronics repair shops

Two total: Located Underground of C Building and on the ground floor of Building 7 in the South District of Student Apartments (east of Qingfen Yuan).

Stationery shops

There are many stationery shops on campus, offering basic stationery, electronics and sports equipment. You can find them in the Tmall supermarket of C Building, in the shop area to the east of Guanchou Yuan canteen, and on F1 floor of Ziguang House (opposite Second School Gate).

Print shops

Printing on campus is very convenient. Printers can be found in libraries, in some teaching buildings and in department office buildings. There are also many print shops dotted around the campus: Buildings 1, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 of Zijing Students Apartment, C Building, the basement of Guanchou Yuan canteen, the south section of Building 7 and the south section of Building 25.

Online Shopping

Online shopping is very convenient and efficient in China. Payment can be made using Alipay, WeChat Pay or a Chinese bank card (when applying for a bank card, authorize the ability to support online purchases). Some sellers will also accept payment upon delivery. When making purchases online using Alipay, WeChat Pay or a bank card, protect your personal information and privacy.

Products purchased online will be sent to the package collection point nearest to your receiving address. When they are ready to be picked up, you will receive messages by text or updates on the app, which you can use to collect your parcels from the specified package collection point.



Postal and Delivery Services

Post Office (China Post)

Location: 1st floor of C Building China Post branch

Opening hours: Monday to Sunday, 9:00-16:00

* Note that this branch cannot send overseas parcels.

Location: Zhaolanyuan (照澜院) Post Office (China Post)

Opening hours: Monday to Sunday, 9:00-17:30

* When sending parcels overseas, a passport must first be presented at the service counter.

General Delivery Service

For those who live in the Zijing area, there is a general delivery service point located in the northern part of the campus behind Zijing Apartment Building 14.

Express Package Locker

Deliveries made to an on-campus dormitory address will be placed, if not in the general delivery service center, in various parcel lockers on campus, located in the Zijing dormitory area, the south dormitory area, and behind Zijing Apartment Building 14.



Transportation

Campus Shuttle Bus

The campus has an electric shuttle bus service. The purple-colored buses stop at marked stops as the following figure shows. The available operating routes are as follows: Outer Route, Inner Route, Student Route, Elderly Route.



Outer route

Operating hours:

Monday to Friday, 7:20- 18:00

Weekends and holidays, 8:30-17:40

The actual operating times during summer and winter vacations are subject to notice.

Operating mode:

Leaves from the West Gate. Runs both clockwise and anticlockwise along the route. Buses depart approximately every 20 minutes in the same direction (every 10 minutes in alternating directions).

Anticlockwise: On weekdays, the 7:20 7:30, and 7:40 shuttles go in the direction of the Indoor Swimming Pool. Later, they head towards the same way but at 10, 30 and 50 of every hour.

Clockwise: On weekdays, the 7:50 shuttle go towards the East Gate. Later, they head towards the same way at 0, 20 and 40 of every hour.

Route stops:

Century Forest - Indoor Swimming Pool - Schwarzman College - Southeast of Zijing Sports Field - Yushu Yuan - Zijing Yuan - North Gate - Low Carbon Energy Building - Li Wenzheng Library - West Sports Field - Science Building - Northwest Gate - University Hospital - West Gate - Outdoor Swimming Pool - Logistics Office - Zhong Lou Building 5 - No. 7 Flat - Elderly Activity Center - Zhaolanyuan - South Gate of East Building - Lee Shau Kee Science and Technology Building - Main Gate - Academy of Arts and Design - Art Museum -East Gate

Inner route

Operating times:

Monday to Friday, 7:40-11:10, 12:40-17:25

Not in operation on weekends, holidays, or summer and winter vacations.

Operating Mode:

Buses depart approximately every 30 minutes in the same direction (every 15 minutes in alternating directions). On weekdays the shuttles start towards East Gate at 10 and 40 of every hour, and towards Northeast Gate at 25 and 55 of each hour.

Route stops (anticlockwise):

Century Forest - Notheast Gate - Northeast of Zijing Sports Field - Southeast of Zijing Sports Field - Schwarzman College - Tingtao Yuan - Li Wenzheng Library - West Sports Field - Science Building -

Northwest Gate - Campus Hospital -West Gate - Outdoor Swimming Pool - Logistics Office - Second School Gate - New Tsinghua Xuetang - West Main Building - Art Museum - East Gate

Route stops (clockwise):

The reversion of the anticlockwise route.

Student route

Monday to Friday: 7:40, 9:20, 13:00, and 14:50.

Not in operation on weekends, public holidays, or summer and winter vacations.

Operating Mode:

The words "student route" (学生专线) are marked on the bus, for student use only. Each route begins at Taoli Yuan and is fixed with stops at designated stations.

Elderly route

Operating times:

Monday to Friday, starting from 7:20

Not in operation on weekends and holidays. Operating time on summer and winter vacations is subject to the notice then.

Operating Mode:

A board with "Jinglao Zhuaxian" (敬老专线) is put up on the bus. These buses travel along South line, North line or East line. It has no halfway stops.

South line:

Originated from the gate of Southeast Neighborhood at 7:30 on weekdays, the bus gets ready between Building 1 and Building 2 in Lanqiying Neighborhood (蓝旗营小区). It then starts from Lanqiying at 7:40, and enters the university through Southwest gate, pass Building 5 of Southwest Neighborhood (西南小区 5 号楼) and its Community Committee, and finally arrives at Campus Hospital.

North line:

Depart from the South Gate of Xueqingyuan Neighborhood (学清苑小区南门) at 7:20 on weekdays and head to Campus Hospital.

East line:

Depart from the South Gate of Shuangqingyuan Neighborhood (双清苑小区南门) at 7:20 on weekdays and head to Campus Hospital.

Return line:

Depart from the South of Campus Hospital at 9:30 on weekdays and return to the neighborhoods mentioned above.

Line 1: from Campus Hospital to South Gate of Xueqingyuan, South Gate of Shuangqingyuan. Get on at East of Jinchun Yuan (近春园东部, on Jinchun Road). The buses waiting face north.

Line 2: from Campus Hospital to North Gate of Lanqiying Neighborhood. Get on at the South of Campus Hospital or the North of Jinchunyuan Hotel (近春园宾馆). The buses waiting face south.

Navigation Apps

Navigation apps can help to plan routes by driving, walking, riding, taking buses and subways or these combined. Real-time traffic information and voice instructions are available during navigation. Bicycles

- Most Tsinghua students and scholars get around campus using bicycles.
- A new bicycle costs 200-500 RMB, depending on your needs and preferences. People may opt to purchase second-hand bicycles from bicycle repair shops on campus, which usually cost no more than 200 RMB. Free (second-hand) bikes may be taken from the charity bike pick-up area near Zijing Building 8 on registration day.
- There are many small bicycle repair shops across campus, offering both free services like tire pumping and seat adjustment, and paid services. Below are the locations of some bicycle repair shops.

Sports and Leisure

Tsinghua has a long sporting tradition and encourages students and scholars to participate in sporting activities regularly. A broadcast calling everyone to exercise at five o' clock every day is one example. The campus is fully equipped with many different sports facilities, including more than 10 sports grounds and 6 lit courts at night.

Chenming Swimming Pool (Indoors)

The Tsinghua University swimming pool was the training spot for the 2008 Olympics and Paralympics. It was also the venue for the 21st International University Sports Federation Competition. The complex is equipped with a swimming pool, one diving area and one dry land diving training area. The 50-meter-long swimming pool is divided into shallow and deep-water areas. The depth is between 1.2 and 1.4 meters in the shallow end while between 2.2 and 2.4 meters in the deep end.

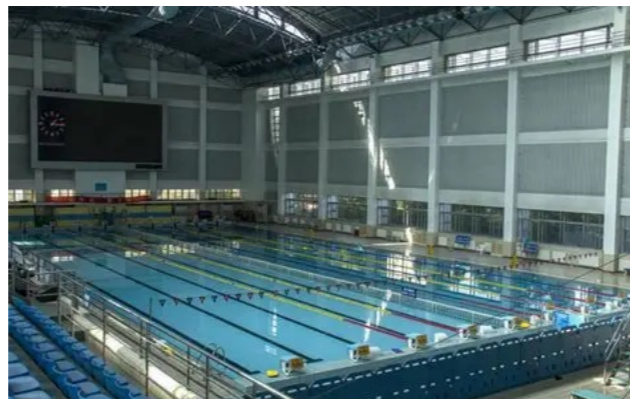

The West Lake Swimming Pool usually opens during the spring and summer season. It has separate shallow and deep-water regions. The depth is 1.8 meters in the deep area.

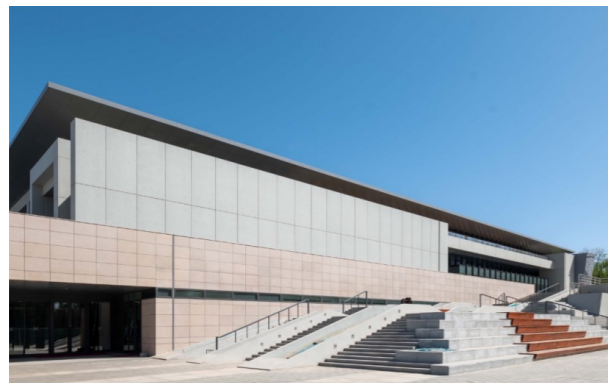

North Gymnasium

The North Gymnasium consists of tennis courts, table tennis rooms, basketball and volleyball courts, fitness rooms, physical rehabilitation centers, a simulated skiing hall, an ice sports center, a fencing room, squash rooms, and aerobics and artistic gymnastics. With a total indoor area of 38,280 square meters, it is the largest indoor activity venue at Tsinghua.

Tsinghua University Campus Card and Campus QR code

The Campus Card is a multi-functional card essential for daily life on campus. The campus code is a dynamic QR code linked to the campus card, which refreshes automatically every 30 seconds. It is one's pass to the university and its dormitories, libraries and many other buildings like the Art Museum. It is also one's canteen card and may be used to pay in some campus supermarkets. You can also get a discount when buying tickets for the swimming pool or for performances at the Auditorium and Music Hall. The Campus QR code (or Xiaoyuan ma) is linked to the Campus Card. It is also a pass to the university and can be used to pay for meals in canteens. It can be accessed through the WeChat mini-program Tsinghua University Campus Card (清华校园卡).

How to get your Campus Card

The card will be issued during registration.

For international scholars
After completing the onboarding procedure or a contract renewal, your Campus Card will be issued. You can send your identification photo to card@tsinghua.edu.cn beforehand. Please make sure you wear dark-colored top with a collar on a white background when taking the photo. You can also choose to take a photo on-site.

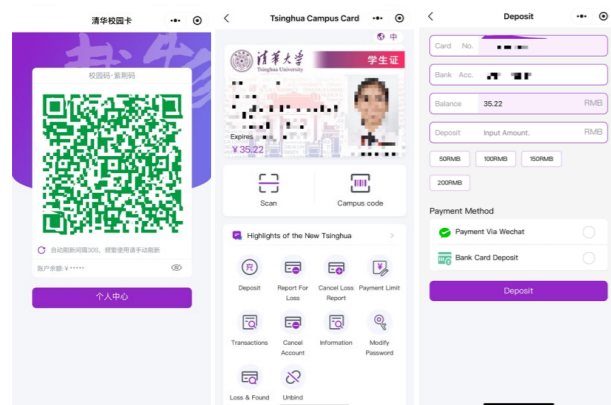
How to recharge your Campus Card on the "Campus Card" WeChat program

Step 1: Open WeChat and search for the "Tsinghua University Campus Card (清华校园卡)" mini-program.

Step 2: The first page may display the dynamic QR code "Xiaoyuan Ma", click the "Personal Center" (个人中心) button underneath to see the full menu.

Step 3: Press the "Deposit" option to load money.

Note: For non-degree program students, the recharge and payment system is different; these students can contact their academic program officer for specific information.



Lost Campus Cards

For international students
Click the "Report for Loss" on "Tsinghua University Campus Card" mini-program and then obtain the new card on the first floor at C Building, which will cost 20 RMB.

For international scholars
Call 62782323 to report the loss, and to freeze the money in your card. If your Campus Card expires and you need to renew it, please first make sure that your contract with Tsinghua has been renewed.



Money and Finances

In China, most payments are currently handled via two mobile payment providers: WeChat Pay and Alipay. Paying with cash and cards, especially in big cities, is not common anymore. Though WeChat Pay and Alipay both offer the same basic functions, such as instant payment, receiving money, and ordering and paying for taxis, it is recommended to set-up both Alipay and WeChat pay, as some vendors or online services may prefer one over the other.



WeChat (微信)

WeChat is similar to Line or WhatsApp, and is the main platform for online communication in China. Once you have set up your WeChat account, you can set up your 'WeChat wallet' to use WeChat Pay. Only Chinese bank cards can be linked. Ensure the name you input in the WeChat Wallet exactly matches the name on your Chinese bank card to link it successfully.



Alipay (支付宝)

Similar to WeChat pay, you need to link up your bank card to use Alipay. Alipay is also used for making payments on many online shopping platforms like Taobao, China's 'eBay', which also has an English version.

Financial scams

Due to the prevalence of mobile payments, being aware of personal phone security is paramount. Particularly in WeChat, where you "befriend" with many others, you should be cautious about strangers requesting to be friends and should not reply to any suspicious message or click any unknown links. Otherwise, you may suffer from losses of your property and personal information. When purchasing items, you will pay by either showing your payment QR code to the vendor or scanning the vendor's QR code (receiving payment). When displaying your QR code or inputting your payment password, be mindful of anyone near you who might peek at your information.

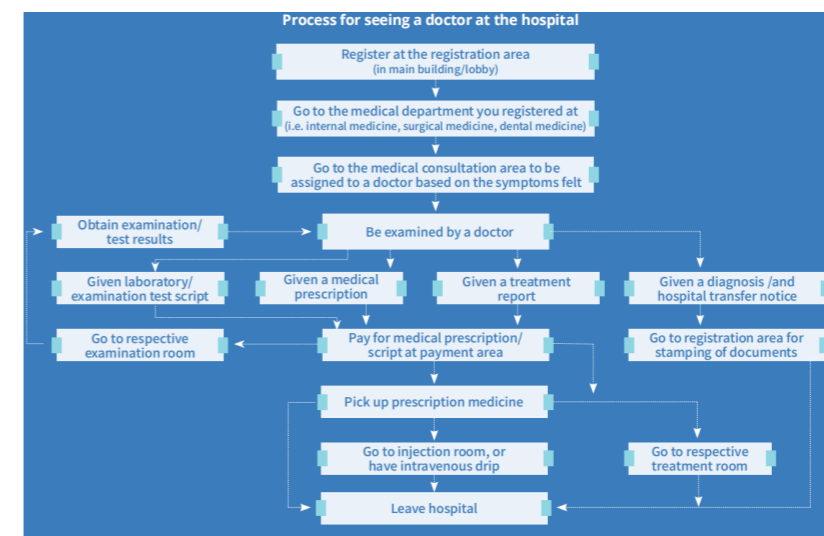

General Safety Tips:

- Take care of personal belongings, especially passports, phones, laptops, and wallets. Avoid carrying too much cash with you.
- Be aware of telecommunications fraud. Do not transfer money or write checks to unknown accounts or individuals.
- Pay attention to information safety. Do not leak information to unknown people through phone calls, texts, WeChat, or the Internet. If necessary, the police can be contacted by calling 110.

Online Shopping Safety:

- Compare different online shopping platforms before buying an item, such as the platform's trade volume and customer reviews.
- Businesses with an offline store or a seven-day return policy can better guarantee customer rights and are thus more reliable.
- Use third-party payment platforms to minimize the risk of transaction issues. Keep records of communication, delivery numbers, and evidence of payments.
- After receiving the purchased item, open and inspect the package immediately. If the product does not match the advertisement or has quality issues, the recipient has the right to reject the delivery. Do not click "confirm delivery" (确认收货) if the item has not yet arrived.
